

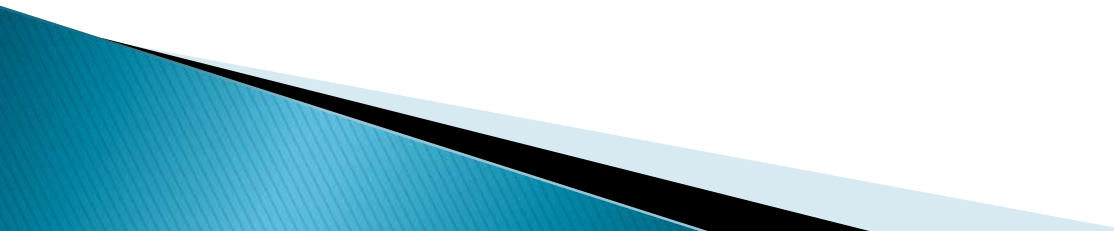

# Many achievements last year


- ▶ Joined WMAT

- ▶ We saw a huge improvement in outcomes of pupils across the school in all year groups.
