Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very pleased to have launched our See-saw online learning platform this week for Year 1 to 6. Reception children are continuing to use Tapestry to share their learning activities. It has been a delight to see the videos, photos and drawings that the children are doing to respond to the familiarisation activities on Seesaw. Today our sharing is our first short assembly, presented by myself. It focuses on the importance of positivity at this time. This can be accessed by logging in to Tapestry or Seesaw. A staff member will do an assembly each week on a different theme.

Daily activities for each class will be launched through Seesaw at 9am each morning. Reception children will continue sharing their learning from their weekly overview, via Tapestry. We hope that the children enjoy responding to these and receiving likes or comments from their teachers and teaching assistants. There is no expectation that the children do all activities as we realise families are all in different circumstances at this time. We are also happy to see other home learning above the 3 activities that have been shared.

In a couple of weeks we are planning to launch the family app so do look out for more information on this coming soon.
