School Facebook page

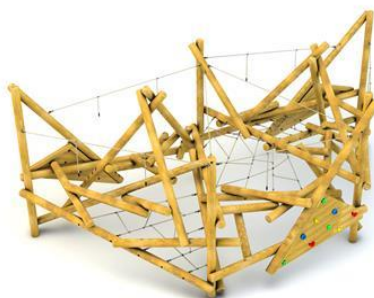
