



The Meadows KS2 Acceptable Use Agreement Primary School


As a family we understand that there are many types of computer, including tablets, games consoles and phones.

We will use our computers and the internet safely and sensibly as part of a range of leisure activities.


When I use any computer, I will be SMART:




SAFE - I will not give out my name, address, photograph or phone number.



MEETING - I will not meet people I chat to on the internet unless a trusted adult comes too.



ACCEPTING - I will only accept and open messages from people I know and trust.



RELIABLE - I know that some people online do not tell the truth and pretend to be friends when they are not - I will check what is true with a trusted adult at home.



TELL - I will tell a trusted adult if I see something I do not think is right online or if someone is unkind or worries me.

If I need to make a username or password I will let a trusted adult at home know.

If I have a username or password I will keep it safely within my family. I will not share it or try to use any other person's username or password.

I will check that my teacher or a trusted adult at home knows which sites I visit on the internet.

I will be polite and responsible when I communicate with others on line using any computer or mobile phone.

I will not take or share photos or video images of others without their permission.

I will be aware that I cannot control how others may share photos and videos taken of me

I will ask for help from a teacher or a suitable adult if I am not sure what to do or I think I have done something wrong

I will tell a teacher or suitable adult if I see something that upsets me on any device.

I will not use chat or social networking sites at school.

I will only use the school's ICT equipment and emails for school use.

If I am using the internet for research I will not copy the work of others. I will also be careful to check that the information I access is accurate as some sites can be misleading.

If I download music, images or videos that are protected by copyright, I will acknowledge the source.

I will take care of school equipment. This includes not installing any new software or downloading/uploading files that could be harmful.

I will not use my personal mobile devices in school.

I will tell my teacher or a trusted adult at home if I think that one of my friends is not keeping the SMART Rules with the technology that we use.

I know that my parents/teachers will check what I have been doing on the computers/internet/e-mail and mobile technology.

If I use ICT/mobile equipment in an inappropriate way, I am aware that this will be reported to the Head teacher and my parents.
