Dear parents/carers,

I would like to thank you for your patience, understanding and support during this difficult and unpredictable time.

You should have received a letter today, via email from Andrea Arlidge, with regards to the school closing on Friday to most children. We will be in touch soon when we have more information.

In the meantime, the staff have been busy creating information and packs to support you with home learning during the school closure. You would have already received a letter giving many links to websites where you can access learning ideas. The teachers have now created more specific information for their year groups, and this will be added to our website in the classes section, under each year group, and labelled as home learning. These packs will be available to access from 4pm on Friday.

If you do not have internet access, or you are unable to print at home, please contact the school office and we will prepare paper copies for your child to take home. If you need this and you are currently self-isolating, please email the office and we can arrange for someone to drop these to your house or post them to you.

If you have any questions about home learning, we can send emails to your child's teacher and they will respond.

We will be in touch shortly with information about key workers to ascertain who will need to access educational provision during the closure.
