



### All Around the World

Dear Parents and Carers,

Our topic next term will be 'All around the World'. The children will be able to compare different parts of the world, name ways to help look after the planet and know who Amelia Earhart is.

In Maths, we will continue to encourage children to share fairly and recognising and making equal groups. We will also provide opportunities for children to replicate simple constructions, models, real places, and places in stories, prompting them to use positional language to describe where objects are in relation to other items.

In English, key text will include *Someone swallowed Stanley*, the 100-decker bus, *Martha Maps it Out*, *The Pirates Next Door* and *The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch*. Along with a range of non-fiction books.

We will change all children's books on Monday and the timetable remains the same as term 5 - PE on Mondays and outdoor learning in our forest area on Wednesdays.

Please support your child by reading 4 times a week at home and completing their spellings. This is in their blue spelling book. Spellings include red words and words with sounds they have learnt.

If you would like to do any home learning with your child during the half term holidays, why not use Google Earth to explore where you live and look up places you would like to visit; talk about places around the world you have visited, or places that family members or friends live; or look at the places on a map and talk about ways to travel. If you go on holiday, send a postcard to school to show where you went! Please don't forget to upload any photos / videos to us through Tapestry as we'd love to see what you've been up to.
