Dear Parents and Carers,

Our topic next term is called 'Change and Growth'. The children will be able to name the four seasons, know the lifecycle of a chick/frog and know what a plant needs to grow. We will be growing our own class sunflower!

In English, key texts will include Jack and the Beanstalk, the enormous turnip, and the little red hen. Along with a range of non-fiction life cycle books.

In Maths, we will look to 20 and beyond, adding and taking away to 10, we will manipulate shapes, compose shapes, and decompose shapes. Please keep using Doodle Maths for their homework. This is a great way to revisit and consolidate previous learning.

In PSHE, we will be looking at 'Relationships'. The children will be looking at my family and me, making friends, falling out and bullying and being the best friends we can be.

We will change all children's books on Monday and the timetable remains the same as term 4 - PE on Mondays and outdoor learning in our forest area on Wednesdays.

Please support your child by reading 4 times a week at home and completing their spellings. This is in their blue spelling book. Spellings include red words and words with sounds they have learnt.

If you would like to do any home learning with your child during the half term holidays, why not take a trip to the local garden centre, go on a walk and spot new life/signs of spring, grow some vegetables or plants, or visit a farm.
